



## Baby Bookworms Activity List

Try these fun activities with your baby bookworm.  
Complete 15 activities & return to the library for prizes!

- Sing a song with rhyming words, such as “Do Your Ears Hang Low?”
- Paint pieces of dried macaroni, let them dry, and string them on yarn to make necklaces.
- “Adopt” a stuffed animal pet. Talk about how to take care of it.
- Do finger plays and action rhymes anytime.
- Go on a shape hunt while shopping together - how many triangles can you find?
- Share a story about your childhood.
- Share a book about your favorite animal.
- Talk about the various sounds you hear as you go about your day.
- Let your child make music with kitchen items like pots, lids, and spoons.
- Read a story about a famous musician.
- Count with your child as you drive in the car (signs, cars, trucks, etc.).
- Dance with your child; add scarves for colorful fun.
- Sing "The Wheels on the Bus" and do motions to match the words.
- Read a nonfiction (true) book with your child.
- Page through a picture book and tell each other a story based only on the pictures.
- Read wordless books with your child.
- Play a board or card game with your child.
- Attend a library program.
- Make animal noises together.
- Put a puzzle together with your child.
- Go on a sensory walk together. Talk about what you see, hear, feel, and smell.
- Use finger paint to draw shapes and write letters.
